U.S., Bulgaria still wrangling over bases

SOFIA, Bulgaria -- The leaders of Bulgaria's coalition government met Monday to discuss the location of the two proposed U.S. bases in Bulgaria.

There remain some outstanding issues in the bilateral U.S.-Bulgarian negotiations over the facilities, including which flag will be hoisted.

The Sofia news agency reported Monday that Prime Minister Sergey Stanishev, Simeon II National Movement leader Simeon Saxe-Coburg, and ethnic Turks' party Movement for Rights and Freedoms leader Ahmed Dogan unanimously agreed that the Bulgarian flag should be flown over any U.S. bases on Bulgarian territory.

Two other issues remain to be resolved. One is the legal status of U.S. soldiers using the bases, according to Foreign Affairs Minister Ivailo Kalfin.

The second issue is whether Washington will warn Bulgaria in advance if bases on Bulgarian territory will be used for attacks against other nations, particularly Iran Bulgarian and a U.S. working group are finalizing the technical parameters of the agreement.

The two proposed bases are an airfield at Bezmer and a training facility at Novo Selo. A second airfield at Graf Ignatievo is still under negotiation.

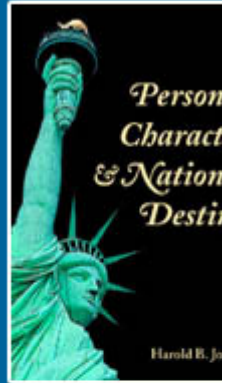
