## Israelis arrested in Samaná are taken to Dominican capital

SANTO DOMINGO.- Two Israelis accused of trespassing on private property in Samaná were brought yesterday to the Dominican Capital, where they are being questioned as to the origin of their military equipment, including communications geographic location, and night viewing.

Levy Alom and Tatroashvili Meir arrived in the country presumably from Miami and the authorities suspect that they were in the country to carry out some special task which they did not reveal.

For his part, the lawyer Plinio Jacobo denounced that three Israelis were arrested in his property, specifying that last Sunday the 6th, the foreigners evicted an employee from a house he owns in the beach at Rincon, Samaná (northeast), and that they were accompanied by four private guards.

Jacobo stated that he went to his house with authorities, and as the foreigners resisted leaving the residence, resulted in the arrest of two of the three.
