**Project 02** is part of Google's expansion plan beyond the current estimated total of 450,000 search servers at Google<sup>[1]</sup>. Two of the buildings are reported to be under construction at The Dalles on the Columbia River on the Oregon side. A Microsoft researcher has reported that a scale model of this server farm, which he toured in Silicon Valley, contains only 10,000 search servers.

Construction was apparently soon to begin October 12, 2005.<sup>[2]</sup> Local officials say they cannot comment about the facility because they signed confidentiality agreements. However, the 30 acre site has buildings the size of two football fields with two four-story-tall cooling towers.<sup>[3]</sup>
