### Questioning Richard Clarke

On Saturday, October 23, Richard Clarke, author of "Against All Enemies" spoke at the Flint Center in Cupertino, with Angie Cairo from KQED's Forum.

As Brouillet reported, he started with his "usual talk" including how Democrats could fight the war on terrorism better than the current administration including some "hawkish " talk about "real threats" like Iran and North Korea.

At one point, 9/11 truth activist Brouillet had the opportunity, to confront Clarke with some questions:

**"On 9-11 there were multiple exercises going on involving NORAD, the FAA, the CIA, involving a drill simulating a plane crash into a building, a live fly hijacking drill, inserting false blips/inserts on radar screens.**

Were you unaware of those drills? Who was coordinating them from the White House? Bush gave Cheney authorization in May 2001 to co-ordinate counter-terrorism responses over multiple agencies. Was he in charge?..."

Brouillet reported, that Clarke "claimed that he was in charge when he arrived at the White House. He said that the May 8th order was for Cheney to "oversee" not coordinate."

Brouillet continued to ask:

"But you didn't get there until 9:03, according to your book," I said,  
"What about before then, they knew about the hijackings at 8:20."

Clarke answered, "Read the 9-11 Commission Report."

Brouillet replied, "It's a whitewash. What about the chemical warfare attack drill scheduled for New York City on September 12th? Were you aware of that?"
