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

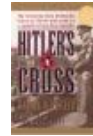
So to answer why these don't translate into real votes: The

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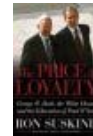
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average american is not going to show up at this straw poll, the average american is also not going to vote for Ron Paul.

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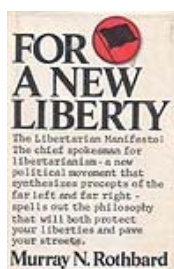
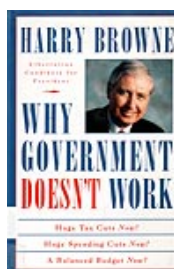
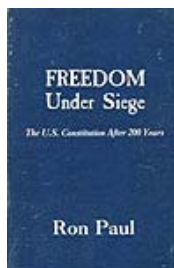
