N Korea threatens US with 'sacred war'

The USS George Washington has arrived at a port in Busan for military drills.

North Korea has threatened to use what it describes as a powerful nuclear deterrent in response to a US-South Korea joint naval maneuver.

Pyongyang says it would begin a "sacred war" against the United States and South Korea at any time necessary.

"All these war maneuvers are nothing but outright provocations aimed to stifle the Democratic People's Republic of Korea [North Korea] by force of arms," the state-run Korean Central News Agency cited the National Defense Commission as saying.

"The army and people of the DPRK will start a retaliatory sacred war of their own style based on nuclear deterrent any time necessary in order to counter the US imperialists and the South Korean

puppet forces deliberately pushing the situation to the brink of a war."

In response, the United States has said it is not interested in a war of words with North Korea.

Washington and Seoul have announced the joint naval exercises to begin on Sunday to deter North Korea's aggressive behavior.

Tension has increased on the Korean peninsula since the sinking of a South Korean warship earlier in March.

Seoul and Washington have blamed a North Korean torpedo for the sinking of the *Cheonan*, which left 46 sailors dead.

The North, however, has rejected the claim as a "smear campaign," insisting that its navy did not torpedo the South Korean ship.

Pyongyang says the naval exercises are a grave threat to the Korean Peninsula.

China also has repeatedly warned against the exercises and called on all sides to show restraint.
