Ahmadinejad wants to debate Obama

Iranian President Mahmoud Ahmadinejad proposed today that United States President Barack Obama contend to a face-to-face debate with him at the United Nations if he is re-elected next month as Iran's president.

“Of course this time, if I am elected as president by the great nation of Iran, I will extend that invitation [to President Obama] one more time for a debate at the UN headquarters,” President Ahmadinejad said on Monday.

During his previous visit to the United Nations headquarters he invited former US President George W. Bush to join him in a debate on global issues.

Though Mr.Ahmadinejad requested a debate today many Americans don't realize that this is not the first time he has called on talks with Obama.

Since February, Ahmadinejad expressed willingness for dialogue but stressed that negotiations should be held “in a climate of fairness with mutual respect.”

According to Iranian news outlet,PressTV,

Tehran — a signatory to the nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty – insists its nuclear program is aimed at civilian purposes and refuses to relinquish its ‘inalienable’ rights to achieve the nuclear know-how according to NPT regulations”
