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## Response from Congress. Michaud (D)

On March 21st, 2009 [gredy4u](#) says:

Thank you for contacting me in support of fiscal responsibility and balancing the federal budget. I appreciate hearing from you on this important issue.

I believe strongly in fiscal responsibility. For my entire twenty-two year career in the Maine Legislature, I worked with my colleagues on a bipartisan basis to write balanced budgets. In Congress, I am a member of the Blue Dog Coalition of fiscally responsible Democrats who advocate for reducing taxes and spending, and balancing the budget. Balancing the budget will be a difficult challenge given our current economic situation and the unchecked growth in federal spending over the last eight years, but we must achieve fiscal discipline.

In the 110th and 111th Congress we enacted common-sense budget reforms such as "Pay-As-You-Go" (PAY-GO) budget rules. PAY-GO requires that all new spending and tax cut proposals show how they will be paid for without increasing the deficit. In the last session Congress, I also cosponsored H.J.Res. 45, which proposes a balanced budget amendment to the Constitution of the United States. The constitutional amendment would require that the President submit a balanced budget to Congress each year and would prohibit Congress from expending more than is brought in each fiscal year.

Early in the current session of Congress, I voted against the House rules package offered by my party because it failed to responsibly protect the fiscal health of the country. By including in the rules package a provision to repeal the so-called Medicare trigger, congressional leaders failed to deal with the long-term deficit faced by Medicare. The Medicare trigger is a legislative mechanism that states that if Medicare is financed by over 45% of general revenue, more than two years in a row, a plan must be presented as to how to make up the shortfall. Eliminating the Medicare trigger without replacing it with anything or responsibly addressing the long-term fiscal stability of this program, spending financed by the taxpayers could increase uncontrollably.

I agree with you that we must continue to decrease the tax burden, control spending and cut wasteful spending, and balance the budget. Every American needs to balance their checkbook. The federal government needs to do the same. I share your support of balancing the budget, and I will continue to support measures that decrease the debt and create economic growth.

Washington, D.C., Mar 19 - Republican Congressman Jeff Flake, who represents Arizona's Sixth District, today introduced legislation to bring the U.S. into compliance with the North American Free Trade Agreement by continuing the U.S./Mexico Cross-Border Land Transportation Demonstration Program.

H.R. 1611 would repeal language included in the FY09 omnibus spending bill that prohibits funding for the demonstration program.
