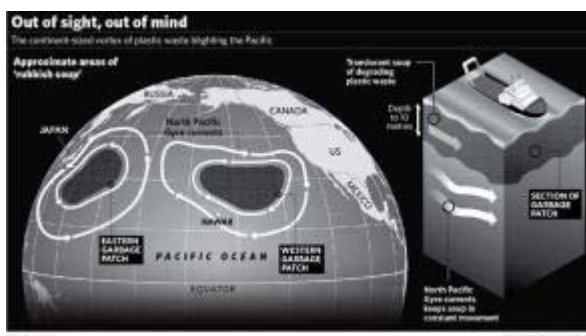

living species in the last 35 years.
