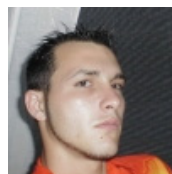

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Last week Japan nuclear radiation was found in California tap water. This week the radioactive contamination has been found in drinking water in Idaho, Washington and Canada.

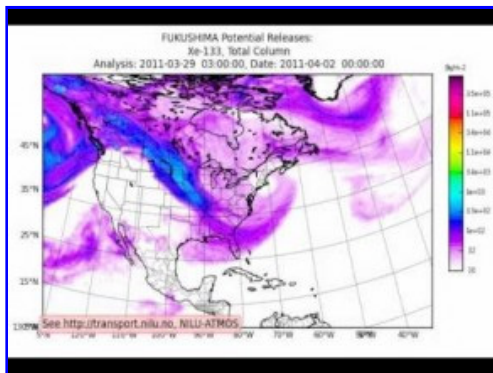

Last week there was news of Japan [nuclear radiation being found in San Francisco, California drinking water](#). Today, new reports reveal that nuclear radiation has also been found in the drinking water in Idaho and Washington.

University of Berkley scientists are reporting the detection of radioactive iodine in the rainwater at levels 18,1000% above federal drinking water limits. Caesium and TE-132 have also been detected.

Scientists have also detected radiation in San Francisco tap water and milk.

Update: Forbes has posted a blurb with a link to the original EPA press release. The Federal Drinking water standard is 3 PCL per liter. Levels detected were 0.2 PCL per liter or 6.66% of federal drinking water standards.

First U.S. Drinking Water Samples Show Radiation from Japan: Boise, Richland Wa.

Drinking water in Boise and Richland, Washington was found to contain extremely small amounts of radioactive isotopes from Japan's nuclear disaster, the Environmental Protection Agency announced Monday night.

The tests were the first tests of U.S. drinking water by the EPA's RadNet system since the Fukushima nuclear accident.

"Drinking water samples from two locations, Boise, Idaho and Richland, Washington, showed trace amounts of Iodine-131 – about 0.2 picocuries per liter in each case," according to the [EPA press release](#).

[Government claims radiation is safe... blah... blah... bullsh*t... blah...] ... But Physicians for Social Responsibility recently [issued a statement](#) asserting "there is no safe level of radionuclide exposure, whether from food, water or other sources. Period." **The results come just two days after radioactive isotopes were found in rainwater samples from [Boise and two other locations](#).** A sample from Washington state showed no detectable radiation in those tests.

Following the highest level of 12 bequerel per litre (bq/l) recorded on March 20, the latest analysis taken on March 29 showed a level of 3.4 bq/l.

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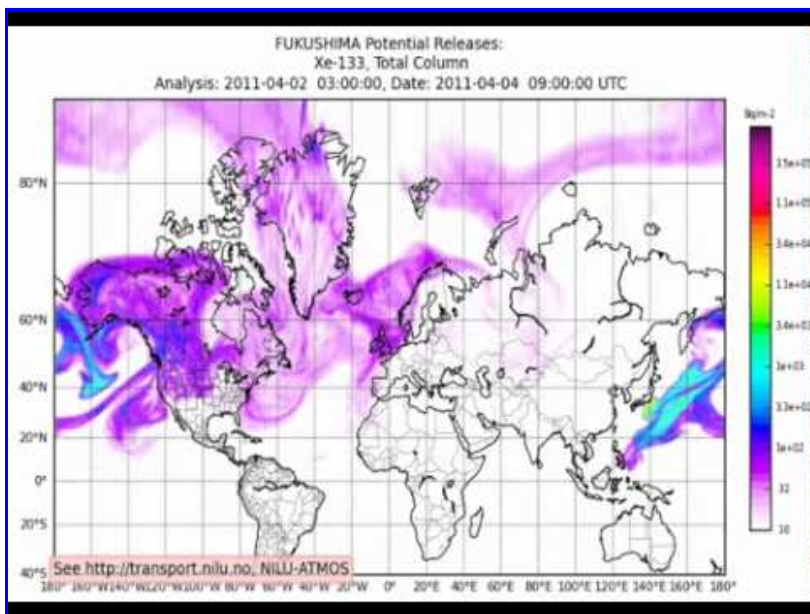

Japan Nuclear Radiation Fallout Forecast For US West Coast On April 6th - 7th 2011
